

### Trends in Registered Nursing Education




#### Total RN Graduations Have Been Relatively Stable Since 2016


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#### The Percentage of BSN Completers Declined Slightly Between 2016 and 2018





## Overall, Job Opportunities are Better for BSNs than for ADNs




#### Variation in Job Market Prospects by Region






#### Less than Half of New Physicians Plan to Practice in New York After Completing Training




#### New York High School Graduates are Most Likely to Practice in New York After Completing Training

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Principal Reason for Practicing Outside New York in 2018





It is intended to support all or part of one year of medical school tuition for students who are from educationally and/or economically underserved backgrounds. In exchange for tuition support, recipients agree to work in an underserved area in NYS upon completion of their medical education.

Regents Loan Forgiveness Award Program

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Regents Physician Loan Forgiveness Award Program is a service-obligated loan repayment program for primary care, internal medicine, emergency

for foreign-trained physicians holding J-1 visas. Physicians are required to

practice in federally designated underserved areas.
