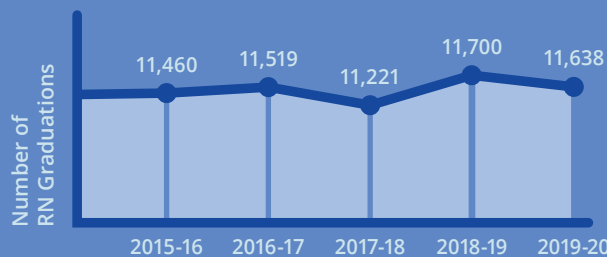

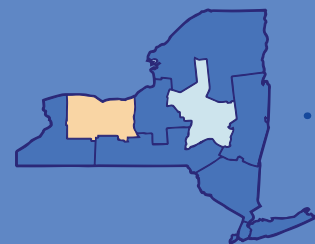


Trends in Registered Nurse (RN) Graduations, 2016-2020

Despite Pandemic Disruptions, RN Graduations Have Remained Relatively Stable



Total RN Graduates Significantly Increased in the Mohawk Valley Region But Declined in the Finger Lakes Region

in Finger Lakes



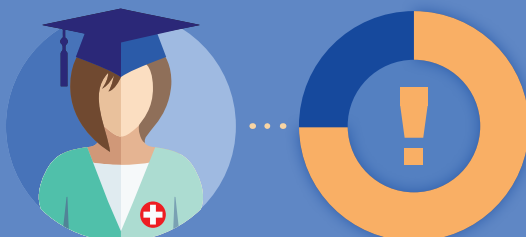
COVID-19 Impacts on RN Education Programs

Substantial Disruptions in Clinical Training in Spring and Fall of 2020



More than **80%** of RN programs used simulation as a strategy to ensure students completed clinical training

71% of RN Program Deans Reported More Demand for New Graduates Due to COVID-19



The Job Market for New RNs Is Strong, Especially in Hospitals and Nursing Homes
