

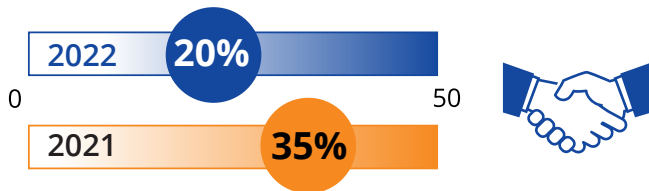


Key Findings From the 2022 New York Resident Exit Survey

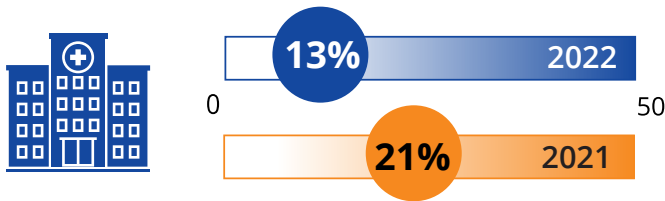
RECRUITMENT

The job market for physicians completing training in New York in 2022 was stronger than the job market in 2021.

20% had difficulty finding a satisfactory practice position

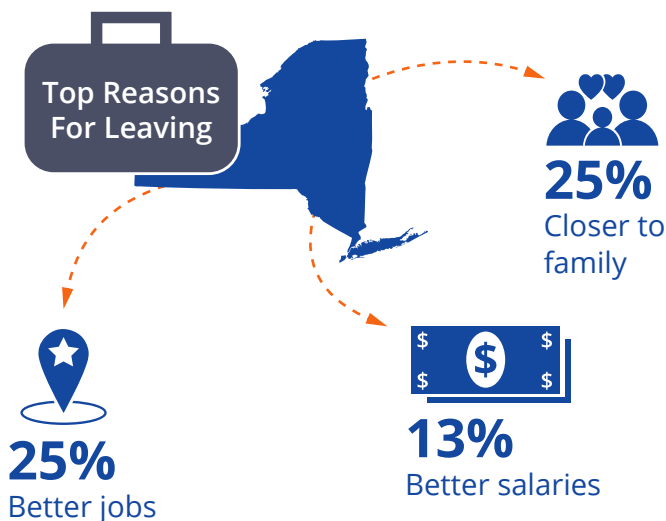


13% changed plans due to limited job opportunities



RETENTION

52% of new physicians trained in NY plan to practice out of state.



DEMAND

Demand for physicians in primary care specialties was comparable to demand for physicians in other specialties according to most indicators.
