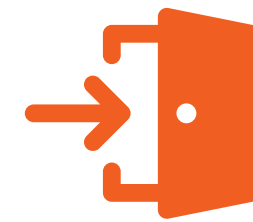
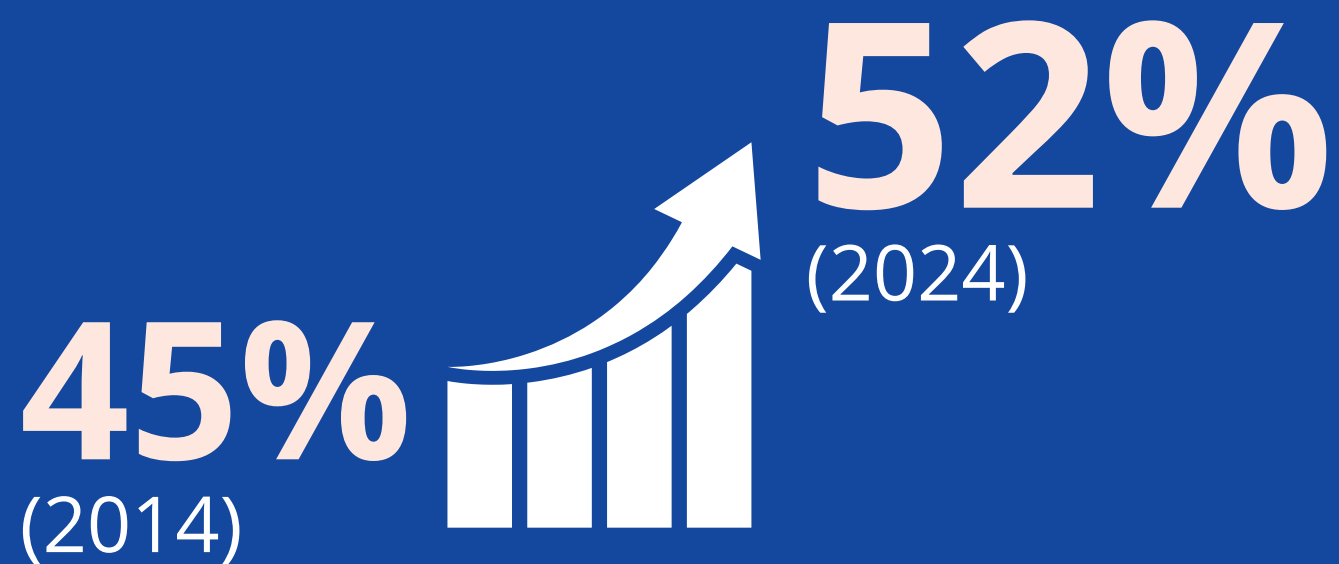


In-State Retention Is on the Rise for New Physicians in NY



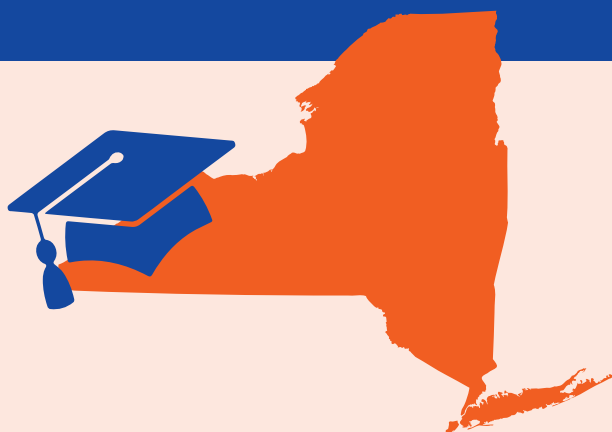
Top Reasons for Leaving NY:

- Orthopedics (17%)
- Pulmonary Disease (28%)
- Obstetrics/Gynecology (33%)
- Ophthalmology (33%)
